



## **Intestinal parasites**

• **Pinworms**: The most common intestinal worm in the U.S. Pinworms are thin and white, about 1/4 to 1/2 inch long.




• **Giardia**: A protozoa that can be transmitted by drinking contaminated water or eating uncooked food.




Cryptosporidium: A protozoa that is a common foodborne parasite.




• **Toxoplasma**: A protozoa that is a common foodborne parasite.




• Trichinella: A roundworm that is a common foodborne parasite.



Anisakis: A roundworm that is a common foodborne parasite.




• Diphyllobothrium: A tapeworm that is a common foodborne parasite.
